PRIVATE BETTY rated off the pace, angled to the inside on the far turn, rallied along the rail to gain the lead nearing the eighth pole, then drew clear. COZZI CAPITAL vied for the lead along the inside, was outmoved into the far turn, angled out for the drive and came on again to gain the place. EXCLUSIVE HOPPER chased the pace into the stretch and gave way. SAINT KNOWS vied for the lead along the inside, drew clear entering the far turn, made the pace into the stretch while coming out a bit, then tired. INDIANSONG failed to menace. SILVERSIDER chased the pace into the far turn, then faltered. SAVEETA was through early.
