**Footnotes**

SAFETY SQUEEZE chased the pace, moved up to engage PUT IT BACK TWENTY on the turn, then dueled with that rival to deep stretch and edged away. PUT IT BACK TWENTY showed speed along the rail, responded when challenged by SAFETY SQUEEZE on the turn, dueled with that rival to deep stretch and yielded. TRIPOFALIFETIME rated off the pace, passed tired rivals for the show. TRIPPBUSTER chased the leaders along the rail into the stretch and gave way. HONEST PAUL unhurried after being steadied at the start, improved his position without threatening. UNDER CONTRACT pressed the pace three wide to nearing the stretch, then tired. KING OF DREAMS broke to the inside contributing to crowding, chased the pace three wide around the turn and faltered. WINTER WEATHER off slowly, failed to menace. DON TELLADAGA steadied from close quarters at the start, then steadied again on the turn and was not a factor. TEN IS ENOUGH was steadied to avoid following KING OF DREAMS in soon after the start, raced three wide around the turn and faded.
