NEMO LANDING stalked the pace off the rail, made a four wide bid leaving the quarter pole, dueled to the lead inside the eighth pole, edged clear then held on well against the advance of the runner-up. MOREAPPLAUSEPLEASE settled back about the three path, angled seven wide at the top of the lane and while closing steadily to deep stretch, ran out of ground. KING COMBO, unhurried inside, bid at the rail near the three eighths pole, eased three wide past the quarter and remained a close factor to the sixteenth pole before leveling off. JABBOK chased the pace inside, eased out through the turn and finished well. HYPHEN stalked the pace about the three path, dueled to a slim advantage midway on the turn and held on to the eighth pole before beginning to weaken. AVEC PLAISIR was outrun toward mid track. REXSON'S ROSE rated the pace off the rail, was pressured toward the three eighths pole then faded nearing the quarter. HONEY HONEY HONEY was a close factor to the head of the lane. COMPRISE was not a factor.
