KIPPERS N' EGGS stalked the pace about the three path, took aim leaving the five sixteenths pole, dueled clear midstretch and was kept alert from there. BARRY K quickly established clear control, was rated to the five sixteenths pole, pressured from that point, dueled close in the upper stretch then yielded to the winner a furlong away and just lasted for place. SHERIFF IRA chased the pace from the three path, was under a full drive past the five sixteenths pole, closed steadily through the lane and just missed place. TRUMP CARD showed no speed off the rail, bid mildly through the turn then leveled out in the stretch. UNTAMEABLE chased the pace inside to the quarter pole, eased out entering the lane but had nothing further. LIQUID LUCK steadied at the start then showed no speed racing well back. PICO BOLIVAR showed no speed outside. BLOWOUT WEEKEND was not a factor. SARAH'SGOTTHECODE showed speed the opening seven sixteenths then faded toward the quarter pole.
