Footnotes

HOLD THAT CAMERA unhurried early, moved to the rail entering the far turn, rallied and slipped through inside HURRICANE LIGHT to gain the lead approaching the eighth pole, then was all out to hold off THOMASQUITO. The latter, rated off the pace, angled out in the stretch and rallied to just miss. LIQUID LUCK vied for the lead off the rail into the stretch, then gave way. HURRICANE LIGHT rank in the early going, moved up inside LIQUID LUCK on the backstretch to vie for the lead, came out a bit while contesting the pace into the stretch, then tired. FATHERS HONOR was stalking the pace when checked from between rivals nearing the end of the backstretch and failed to recover. LE GRAND ROUGE vied for the lead three wide into the backstretch, then couldn't stay with the leaders and faltered in the drive. AZUL COAST saved ground and never threatened.
