**Footnotes**

RACING APTITUDE settled close to the early pace two deep and between horses, angled four wide making a bid toward the quarter pole, dug in for the lead inside the eighth pole and widened slightly with steady handling. THE BEST GLACIER settled off the pace about the three path, edged closer into the final turn, had aim off the hedge into the lane and dug in from there to get place the final stride. AND I LIKE IT TOO, off the pace inside, angled five wide making a bid into the lane, was outfinished in the duel for place though just up for show. THE WACO KID leapt inward from the gate, settled back inside early, closed toward contention midway through the backstretch, had aim at the hedge in the upper stretch and though finished a close factor, was outfinished for second and third the final strides. OLIGARCH rated a clear lead at the hedge, was pressured for run entering the stretch but weakened the final sixteenth. REPRIZED HALO raced close to the early pace while off the hedge, saved ground through the backstretch though was no further factor. RED HILLS appeared dull.
