BIG BAND outrun after he dwelt and ducked out at the start, swung wide for the stretch, then drifted out badly while rallying to be up late. UNTAMEABLE chased the pace four wide, rallied to gain the lead at the sixteenth pole but couldn't resist the winner in the closing strides. HIT THE CYCLE showed speed along the rail, made the pace to the sixteenth pole and gave way. COLLABORATE reserved off the pace after breaking slowly, saved ground while advancing into the stretch but couldn't gain late. SOULFULLY rated off the pace, gained some ground without threatening. WILDCAT SPECIAL was never a factor. WATCH YOUR FINGERS chased the pace three wide around the turn and tired. UPSHOTBEST chased the pace off the rail to the top of the stretch, then faltered.
