THE KAISER was rated in good position along the inside,split rivals while rallying at the quarter pole then closed steadily to get up in the final strides. SCAGNELLI checked slightly and angled in on the first turn, alternated along the inside to the turn, opened a clear lead in upper stretch, continued on the front into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. FORBIDDEN APPLE checked a bit between horses on the far turn, rallied three wide on the turn and finished willingly. STEPHEN'S POKEY was pinched back early, carried wide on the first turn, circled five wide on the turn and rallied mildly. STARSHIP CHARLES saved ground to the turn and finished evenly. KLABIN'S GOLD carried wide on the first turn, dueled to the turn and tired. LEGS GALORE steadied between horses on the far turn and failed to threaten thereafter. BEAU DANCER bore out badly entering the backstretch bothering several rivals. MR. DI MARCO steadied on the first turn, checked on the far turn and tired. CLOUD COVER steadied and was carried very wide on the first turn, checked in traffic on the turn then gave way.
