KEROUALLE chased the pace, made a run to reach the leaders five wide on the turn and tired in the drive. BEDROOM CURE vied for the lead three wide and faltered. LAUREL LIGHT, off slowly, passed tired rivals. ANNATOAGA broke slowly and was never a threat. GOLD FOR MY GAL chased the pace, made a run to reach near even terms for command four wide on the turn, then faded. WANDERING KATIE was outrun while racing wide. DINNER PARDNER, wearing a nasal strip, was hustled to get the lead after breaking slowly, then gave way.
