AIRTITEANNI off slowly, moved up quickly to show speed along the inside, drew clear on the turn, then was fully extended to hold CODE OF JUSTICE safe. The latter, tracked the pace three wide around the turn and was gaining slowly on the winner at the finish. MISS MARONIE chased the pace into the stretch and had no late response. POP POP'S HOPE reserved early, raced three wide on the turn and was not a factor. SALLY DEAR was outrun after she acted up and dwelt at the start. OCALA ROSE showed early foot, stopped and was pulled up in the stretch.
