Footnotes

MR. SAMSON reserved racing along the inside, steadied in behind IDERATHERBEGAMBLIN entering the turn, swung out for the stretch run and rallied under pressure to be up late. IRISH GATO vied for the lead along the rail, drew clear in the stretch but couldn't resist the winner late. VALID DANCER outrun after breaking to the outside and bumping DIAMOND TRIP at the start, angled wide for the stretch run and closed to be up for the show. MOMENT OF SONG rated in striking position off the pace, altered course outside the leaders for racing room nearing the eighth pole, then had no response when clear. DIAMOND TRIP bumped and steadied at the start, raced three wide on the turn and passed tired rivals. BURLEY A chased the pace three wide into the stretch and tired. GREAT HONOREE vied for the lead outside IRISH GATO into the stretch and faltered. SEA CLIP was outrun. IDERATHERBEGAMBLIN showed brief speed and faded.
