HEAR YE HEAR YE chased the pace three wide, rallied to gain a slim lead at the top of the stretch, vied with GOOD TO BE SEEN to deep stretch and edged away. GOOD TO BE SEEN showed speed along the inside, responded when headed by HEAR YE HEAR YE at the top of the stretch, vied with that rival to deep stretch and yielded. MR. GREEN chased the pace, made a run between horses to reach near even terms for command racing into the stretch, then gave way. PEACE AT DAWN rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and had no response when asked. WHAT A PRINCE chased the pace along the rail, angled out for the drive and tired. GESU allowed to settle, lacked a rally. LUCAS BRADY was never a factor. MANNY WHO reserved off the pace, faltered leaving the turn.
