### Footnotes

PASHITO THE CHE chased the pace three wide, rallied to engage PRINCE JOSHUA in early stretch, then dueled with and just edged that rival to the wire. PRINCE JOSHUA set the pace under pressure along the inside, responded when challenged by PASHITO THE CHE in early stretch, then dueled with that rival and was edged to the wire in a game effort. LITTLE NICK pressed the pace outside PRINCE JOSHUA to nearing the quarter pole, then gave way. HYPOCRITE unhurried after breaking slowly, failed to menace. RATE OF EXCHANGE stalked the pace around the turn and tired. GREEN VEGAS raced in contention three wide around the turn, then faltered. HONEY HONEY HONEY chased the pace along the rail into the turn and faded. TRIPPBUSTER raced four wide and trailed.
