### Footnotes

REX'S LAST TOUR rated off the pace, raced four wide around the turn, rallied with DEVIL'S JOY to reach even terms for command at the eighth pole, then edged away from that rival late. DEVIL'S JOY chased the pace three wide, rallied to gain a brief lead at the eighth pole, then stayed with REX'S LAST TOUR to inside the sixteenth pole and weakened. BRIGHT KNIGHT unhurried after bumping soundly with PRIMPFEDENEL at the start, passed tired rivals to be up for the show. SOMEDAY CAME vied for the lead outside SEVEN KIND to nearing the eighth pole, then tired. SEVEN KIND vied for the lead along the rail to the eighth pole, then faltered. ITZMIN off slowly, was not a factor. PRIMPFEDENEL well placed after bumping hard with BRIGHT KNIGHT at the start, faded leaving the turn.
