Footnotes

SIR PHILIP reserved racing along the rail, was taken up on the far turn to avoid running up on TOUCHNLUCK, recovered and rallied along the inside to be up late. ADRIATIC stalked the pace three wide, moved to take over on the far turn and opened a clear lead but couldn't resist the winner late. SERIFANO allowed to settle, circled rivals four wide around the far turn to reach the attending position in the stretch, then flattened out. LEGENDARY STORM unhurried early, raced four wide around the far turn and passed tired rivals. NO GIMMICK outrun after breaking slowly, raced five wide around the far turn and improved his position without threatening. OLE CUVEE reserved early, made a run three wide around the far turn to loom a threat entering the stretch, then tired. CLIFF'S CATCH chased the pace to midway of the far turn, then faltered. INVISIBLE TRICK raced three wide and failed to menace. LUCKY INDIAN was not a factor. SHAKEY GROUND vied for the lead outside TOUCHNLUCK into the far turn and faded. TOUCHNLUCK vied for the lead along the inside to the far turn, then stopped abruptly and was eased in the stretch run. FIVE STAR D J off slowly, was saving ground when eased out to avoid running up on SIR PHILIP on the far turn, then clipped heels with TOUCHNLUCK and unseated his rider. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE FALLEN RIDER.
