SHEBOP allowed to settle, raced three wide around the turn, then rallied under pressure to be up late. CHAR LENA JO bumped with OH SO SHERRI at the start, pressed the pace along the inside, angled three wide after easing back off OH SO SHERRI entering the turn, rallied to catch that rival at the quarter pole and opened a clear lead but couldn't hold off the winner late. SECRET STORM unhurried after bumping with OH SO SHERRI at the start, saved ground around the turn and closed with a belated rally for the show. ELECTRIC RUN rated off the pace, didn't do enough late. PRIVATE CAUSE reserved off the pace, saved ground around the turn and lacked a late response. PEPE'S VALENTINE was not a factor. C U LATOR WERBLIN chased the pace three wide around the turn and tired. OH SO SHERRI bumped between rivals at the start, showed speed off the rail to nearing the stretch, then faltered.
