Footnotes

PUTY BOY broke alertly, prompted the leader from the outside, steered in, challenged along the inside with less than a furlong remaining, well clear late. GOLD VEGAS asked along early to keep up, moved a bit closer on the outside late in the turn, roused upper stretch, could do little with the winner late, up final strides for the place. RONTOS' CODE moved up to clear before a quarter, showed the way in the two path, also proved no match for the winner late, weakened final strides to lose the place spot. DON'TMISSMYACT went evenly throughout in lacking a late bid. KAYATE ECHO brushed at the start while last to leave, raced well off the pace, lacked a response in the drive. INDEED I AM broke in, brushed with KAYATE ECHO, raced back and was never a factor. ENTRY DENIED ran off for a quarter mild prior to the start, was finished before three furlongs.
