### Footnotes

CACTUS KID stalked the pace off the inside, closer three wide turning for home, long drive, put a head in front just inside the furlong marker, fully extended while edging slowly away in the late going. EL UNO broke out, moved off the inside to prompt the leader onto the backstretch, engaged that rival late backstretch to duel through the second turn and into the stretch, held a narrow advantage upper stretch, gave ground grudgingly to the winner. ASSIMILATION lacked early foot, moved outside, came four wide into the lane, drifted in nearing midstretch, straightened and finished up best of the rest. JOROPO last away, completely devoid of early foot, saved ground into the lane when roused, rallied up the inside to improve position. FINANCIAL PATHWAY went evenly throughout. HARRY THE HAWK sprinted clear soon after the start, set a lively set of early fractions, weakened in the drive. KEYHOLE in tight at the start, not a threat. EL RAYITO lacked speed outside, four wide entering the stretch, failed to muster a rally.
