ALLARD forwardly placed outside, moved up four wide to challenge into the turn, brushing with IMPERIAL'S CATCH and causing that foe to steady, tightened up RIVERSTAR soon after causing that rival to check, dueled briefly, shook clear into the lane, drew out through the lane while being kept to task with a brisk left handed whip. FOLLOWING A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF RIVERSTAR AGAINST THE WINNER FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE INTO THE TURN, THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND. EMPEROR'S TUNE fell back in lacking early speed, dropped inside turning for home, rallied up the rail to earn the place, no threat to the winner. GOLDSOME hopped at the start, raced well back early as a result, three wide out of the turn, moved out to be widest for the drive, staged a mild rally to be up for the show. IMPERIAL'S CATCH with the pace while outside and three wide early, brushed with the winner then steadied in tight entering the turn, fell back, four wide into the lane, missed the show. RIVERSTAR vied up front while closest to the inside, checked up when lacking room into the turn, fell back, three wide out of the turn, evenly to the wire while also being outfinished for the show. MAR BRAVO was never a serious threat in lacking a late response. MY OMEGA RUN vied up front for five furlongs between foes and then gave way in the drive. DIAMOND WILLIE saved ground to no avail. TIZ TROUBLE was outrun while racing well off the inside.
