STORMY ROMAN rated off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn, rallied to catch MUSIC'S STORM just inside the eighth pole and edged away under pressure. MUSIC'S STORM quickly moved the fore, made the pace along the hedge to midstretch, then couldn't stay with the winner while continuing on with good courage to hold the place. PROUD MAN unhurried after being steadied from tight quarters in the early going, raced three wide on the far turn and closed to be up for the show. SIR BRIAN'S SWORD stalked the pacesetter into the stretch and weakened. MILITARY MAN reserved early, had no response when set down for the drive. ORCHARD PARK well placed while saving ground, tired in the drive.
