CHILE DUDE broke out, slight brush, settled in behind the pace toward the inside, moved out while continuing to stalk up the backstretch, closer three wide turning for home, challenged outside the leader midstretch, raced on equal terms with that one to the wire, narrowly prevailed while fully extended. G. T. TABU cleared to the inside soon after the start, narrowly set the pace while in hand, headed midway on the second turn, found more and battled back to regain the advantage into the lane, responded when challenged by the winner with a furlong remaining, dulled to the wire inside that rival and narrowly missed in a game effort. KEYNER VELOZ within striking distance, ranged up and put a head in front midway on the final turn, vied between the top two into the stretch, faltered, remained well clear of the others. EXPORTER brushed with the winner start, moved up early to vie for five furlongs, gave way into the far turn. TIZ TIME IS NOW broke a step slow, raced back and never menaced. ANT HILL remained always back. ANGEL DE AMOUR tired outside.
