OUTWILDCATTIN devoid of early foot, advanced in the second turn outside, came four wide into the stretch, angled in to avoid the drifting leader, took over soon after, well clear under steady handling. NEED YOU TONIGHT settled off the pace, raced in the second group toward the inside second turn, no match for the winner in the drive, clearly second best. CHAMPAGNE JANE broke on top, set the pace along the inside, headed, fell back late final turn, came back to overtake a faltering SAMANTHA G for the show, no threat to the top two. SAMANTHA G pulled hard when within striking distance, between foes into the far turn, challenged on the outside turning into the stretch, took over, drifted out, faltered. WIKI WIKI lacked speed outside, came four wide out of the second turn, lacked a serious kick in the drive. CASH BELONGINGS chased early, moved up to challenge into the far turn, gave way in the drive.
