RIO GREY never far back, raced restrained while covered up into the far turn, closer three wide turning for home, bid soon after, kicked well clear while being kept to pressure. VARITEK forced the early pace off the inside, vied 2nd turn, narrowly showed the way into the stretch, proved no match for the winner. SWEETSOUTHERNMAN void of early foot, saved ground into the stretch while still well back, lodged a late run while steadily angling out, missed the place. RUN SMART ONE within striking distance on the outside, floated out a bit by the winner to be four wide into the stretch, lacked a significant closing response and finished up evenly. EL COBRE went evenly paced in lacking a serious late kick. MR. HADIF broke on top, got clear early, set the pace, faltered once headed by the winner turning for home. SIR CHARLIE remained always back. MASTER TASSEL settled off the pace, gave way in the drive.
