Footnotes

PUTY BOY cleared to the inside into first turn causing CHILEAN BOY to steady slightly, duelled with that one onto the backstretch, fell back into the far turn, set down while maintaining inside position, up in time. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF CHILEAN BOY AGAINST THE WINNER FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE INTO THE FIRST TURN WAS NOT ALLOWED. CHILEAN BOY steadied across the winner's heels into the first turn, moved up outside to duel onto the backstretch, shook clear far turn, larger lead stretch, faltered late to be caught by the winner. GTMEOUTAHERESEAMUS jostled just after the start, was allowed to settle, moved a bit closer from between rivals in the second turn, lacked a further response in the drive to finish up best of the rest. EMPEROR'S TUNE forwardly placed while outside, continued to race within striking distance through the final turn, lacked a closing punch in the drive. GIANT VALLEY one paced while within contact of the leaders, roused four wide turning for home, also found lacking when the real running started at the head of the lane. ONE HELLUVA RIDE made little impact while racing off the inside. TIGER'S ARGUMENT last away, no threat. GREYRUNFORNV tired from early efforts.
