RACING FOR PAHM dueled outside for a half,shook loose in upper stretch then held off JOEY'S SISTER under brisk urging. JOEY'S SISTER raced just off the pace three wide to the turn, made a run to threaten in midstretch but couldn't overtake the winner while lugging in during the final eighth. FRANKLIN'S MINT was reserved for a half while saving ground and failed to threaten with a mild late rally. ANNA'S CITY SUE dueled along the inside into upper stretch and tired. NORTHEND FESTIVAL lodged a mild rally from outside on the turn and flattened out. MATTIE KATE bobbled slightly at the start, was never a factor.
