ROCK'N METALLIKA tracked the pace off the rail, angled out leaving the far turn, rallied to take over nearing the eighth pole and drew clear. NAN'S ROSE moved up to gain a slim lead racing down the backstretch, vied for the lead off the rail to midstretch, then couldn't stay with the winner while edging JELLABA'S SONG for the place. The latter, reserved early, saved ground while advancing into the stretch, angled out and couldn't gain on the winner late while just missing the place. ICANSEECLEARLY tracked the pace after breaking awkwardly, made a run three wide to vie for the lead around the far turn and into the stretch, then weakened. NOA'S TOY reserved early, raced three wide on the far turn and lacked a late response. MARIA'S SUNSHINE steadied along the inside soon after entering the first turn, rushed up to get the lead along the rail, responded when headed by NAN'S ROSE on the backstretch, vied for the lead along the rail into the stretch and tired. TECHNICAL QUESTION was through early and eased in the final eighth.
