Footnotes

BINGO BANGO BONGO with the pace from the start, vied between foes, long stretch, dueled, gained the nod at the wire in a determined effort. PALATINE HILL also prominent from the start, contested the pace three wide and outside the winner throughout, hooked up with that rival in a protracted stretch duel, missed outside. WINNER JAK hopped slightly at the start, raced back, closer into the far turn, behind rivals into the lane, dropped to the rail for the drive, finished up best of the rest while not a serious threat to the top two. HUGO LIGHT contested the pace closest to the inside of the first flight, continued to vie into the straight, raced in the two path past the furlong marker, allowed WINNER JAK the inside, weakened. TOM KITTEN broke a step slow, raced off the pace and the inside, raced in some traffic into the stretch, three wide, finished up evenly while between rivals at the line. BUMPY GIN settled in mid pack early, came four wide into the stretch, also was going evenly at the end while well out in course. POWER RULES lacked speed, had little left for the drive. WATCH ROCK was finished after a half, trailed home.
