MUCHO MANS GOLD showed the way onto the main course, rated in setting the pace, called on for some run when the tempo picked up late in the final turn, stretch duel, dug in late to narrowly prevail in game fashion. KIZUNA pressured the winner off the inside, raced on equal terms with that one when asked out of the final turn, outfinished. URQUIA outrun for five furlongs, moved closer in the two path through the second turn, roused, finished with good late energy to be getting to the top pair late. AD MELIORA forwardly placed early along the inside, moved out for the drive, lacked a serious late kick, finished up evenly. SEQUOYAH HILLS settled off the pace, managed little in the way of a rally in the drive. BAHIA DE ORO in a bit tight at the start, trailed, picked off a couple of tiring rivals while not a serious threat. ROYAL BUSINESS prompted the pace three wide, gave way when the real running started at the head of the straight. BROWN EYED SUE well back off the early pace, advanced with a middle move into the second turn, gave way soon after, continued to fade through the stretch.
