Footnotes

ELUSIVE BLUEBOY closest to the leader while being asking along in the turn, dueled into and through upper stretch, disposed of the other speed and kicked well clear. TAPICERO balked at loading, off slowly and a bit awkwardly, raced back early as a result, four wide turn, roused a quarter out, finished up willingly to be in time for the place. MYSTICAL MYLES away well, set the pace toward the inside, raced on equal terms with the winner upper stretch, gave way late, nipped for the place in the final strides. LAKE DRIVE SOUTH closest to the two leaders for a half, in some traffic late, finished up evenly while between rivals at the wire. ARANGOL void of early foot, lacked a serious bid. BLUEGRASS DERBY settled off the pace, lacked a late kick. BLACK LABEL was through early, trailed home.
