DONT MESWIT GOLDIE rated off the pace, angled four wide on the far turn, then rallied to be up in the final strides. KINGS OVER reserved early, rallied four wide to gain a slim lead on the far turn, then dueled with BERNI DE MINT to inside the sixteenth pole, edged away from that rival but couldn't resist the winner late. BERNI DE MINT tracked the pace, rallied three wide to reach near even terms for command midway of the far turn, then dueled with KINGS OVER to past the sixteenth pole and gave way. CRIME FAMILY off slowly, failed to menace. TORMENTO chased the pace along the inside into the stretch and tired. TIGLON was not a factor. ROCKITUDE was outrun after breaking poorly. TORMENTA DEL TIGRE quickly sprinted to a clear lead, made the pace along the inside into the far turn, then had nothing left.
