SUAVE JAZZ reserved early, swung wide for the stretch run, rallied to gain the lead inside the eighth pole, then was fully extended to prevail. WILD EXPECTATIONS off slowly, stalked the pace along the inside into the stretch, eased out and closed to gain the place while unable to get to the winner. MANNY WHO tracked the pace four wide, rallied to gain a slim lead in the stretch but was outfinished. DOC GREEN chased the pace off the rail, made a run to reach near even terms for command in the stretch, then weakened. THESLAYERINTHELANE chased the pace three wide, made a run to reach near even terms for command in midstretch, then gave way. BLACK GABRIEL showed speed along the inside to the eighth pole and tired. QUIET EMARATI raced four wide and trailed.
