MIDNIGHT SCRIMMAGE pushed out a bit at the start, settled in the second flight early between rivals, continued to stalk into the far turn, steered our for room turning for home, split foes past the furlong marker, edged clear under steady handling. REMEMBER LYNN pinched back at the start, trailed for five furlongs, advanced while three out to four wide late in the second turn, challenged outside, second best. HEAR HER ROAR settled off the pace, came four out to five wide into the stretch, finished up best of the rest. SHIFT IT in the second flight while outside, ranged up to challenge midway on the final turn, vied into the stretch, faltered final furlong. MISS LEONARDO dueled early along the inside, chased the leader into the far turn and began to fade. FLORIDA STRAITS broke out, pushing the winner to the outside which in turn pinched REMEMBER LYNN back, dueled early off the inside, got clear before a half, gave way when headed turning for home.
