Footnotes

PINAFRA void of speed, advanced four wide and between rivals turning for home, was bumped by STARSHIP SPARKLE past the furlong marker, came in to bump that same foe soon after, dueled to the wire, edging away late. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE STRETCH RUN, THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND. STARSHIP SPARKLE off the pace, advanced and challenged between foes three wide late in the second turn, gained the advantage, came out to bump with the winner nearing midstretch, bumped by that rival a stride later, outfinished, clearly second best. LUCKY MANDATE settled off the pace, traffic, lacked room upper stretch, got through inside, up late for the show. CAROLINA LIZARD took over soon after the start, set the pace, weakened the final furlong. OPERA HALL stalked outside, four out to five wide turning for home, also weakened in the final furlong. FLY AWAY MARIJA stalked the early pace, lodged a bid in the second turn, brushed in traffic upper stretch, faltered in the drive.
