Footnotes

FIVE AFTERNOONS forwardly placed and between rivals out of the chute, ranged up to challenge on the outside midway on the turn, clear into the stretch, drifted out soon after, held sway in the late going under steady handling. MOTIN in the second group in the back early, shuffled back from between foes into the turn, moved out to be five wide into the stretch, rallied down the middle part of the strip for the place. NAOS lacked speed off the inside, came three wide into the lane, angled in as the winner drifted out upper stretch, closest to that foe with a furlong remaining, lacked a late kick and was caught for the place. MOREAPPLAUSEPLEASE lacked speed off the inside, managed some modest improvement in the lane while not a serious threat. PHILOURPOCKETS last to leave, raced off the pace, lacked a rally in the drive. TRUMP CARD pressed the early pace outside, gave way in the turn. WHATSUPNOTMUCH showed the way early, briefly raced on equal terms with the winner late in the turn, stopped in the drive.
