LIGHTLIVELY taken back and angled in to save ground soon after the start, swung outside the leaders on the far turn and rallied under a confident hand ride to be up late. VOLUNTOWN tracked the pace three wide, rallied to gain a slim lead in midstretch but couldn't resist the winner in the closing strides. SHARP INSULT sprinted to a clear lead, made the pace along the rail into the stretch and weakened. DEPUTY DOLLY unhurried early, advanced between horses on the far turn to reach contention, then lacked a late response. BLUESPEEDWHITELITE saved ground to no avail. GETYOURGUNSANNIE chased the pace, made a run to reach near even terms for command soon after entering the far turn, then tired. FORMAL FANNY was no factor after being caught in tight at the start. RUNAWAY RIZZI tracked the pace four wide in the far turn and faltered.
