Footnotes

PLATINUM LIGHT was carried well past the middle of the racetrack when slammed into by LOVIN' LISA on the first turn nearly unseating her rider, recovered and moved back up to track the leader three wide around the far turn, then responded to pressure in the drive rallied to be up late. HEARTLIGHT off slowly, inherited a clear lead soon after entering the first turn, was carefully handled when the loose horse ranged up outside her on the backstretch, continued to maintain a clear lead off the rail after that rival bore out racing into the far turn, made the pace to deep stretch and was edged to the wire. NANA'S SECRET tracked the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch, then tired. FOR OLGA checked in behind LOVIN' LISA on the first turn, trailed into the far turn and faltered. GOLD STRIPE broke slowly, then was forced out and checked in behind the incident on the first turn, remained in contention into the far turn, then faded. LOVIN' LISA was showing speed along the inside when her rider's left rein broke causing her to bear out and slam into PLATINUM LIGHT on the first turn unseating her rider.
