APRIORITY showed speed off the rail while in hand into the stretch, then drew away when asked. WHERE'S STERLING chased the pace three wide into the stretch but couldn't stay with the winner while clearly second best. VANISHING BUCK unhurried early, saved ground and closed to gain the show while no threat to the top ones. TELLUM BERTO pressed the pace along the rail into the turn and tired. JUPITER rated off the pace, faltered. OLE CUVEE was done early and eased in the stretch run.
