Footnotes

EYES FOR LOVE sprinted clear in the early stages, extended her lead on the turn then drew clear under brisk left hand urging. SPRINGINTHECOUNTRY settled just off the pace for a half, circled four wide on the turn and finished willingly from outside to best the others. APPEALING STORM raced in close contention between horses for a half, checked along the inside at the quarter pole then weakened. TWINKLE LITTLE ONE chased the winner along the inside to the top of the stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. EXPRESS FOR MINDY checked in tight on the first turn, moved out along the backstretch, made a run to reach contention in upper stretch and flattened out. SHAINA MONICA never reached contention. SILVER PET was never a factor after being squeezed at the start. SNOW FORTUNE drifted out causing crowding on the first turn, steadied between rivals nearing the backstretch and failed to threaten thereafter.
