RUNAWAY IN LOVE bumped with VONNEGUT at the start, rated off the pace, assumed command midway of the turn three wide then drew off in the drive while being kept to pressure. AUSPICIOUS GIRL unhurried early, raced three wide on the turn and closed to gain the place. VONNEGUT bumped with RUNAWAY IN LOVE at the start, trailed early, raced off the rail around the turn then was checked in traffic turning for home and closed for the show. REALITY TIME stalked the pace, three deep on the turn and gave way in the stretch run. NITRO SHOCK bobbled at the start, reserved off the pace and tired. SALIENT TSUNAMI made the pace off the rail to midway of the turn and faltered. GRAY MARIAH chased the speed, bled and was pulled up in midstretch.
