Footnotes

EL BANK ROBBER unhurried after being steadied at the start, angled out and rallied four wide on the far turn, moved to take over at the eighth pole, then edged away under pressure. SANDY BAY reserved racing along the rail, was steadied to avoid running up on NIJINSKY BULLET leaving the turn, angled out for room in the stretch and closed to gain the place. COVENT GARDEN outrun early, angled out for the stretch run and rallied to be up for the show. NIJINSKY BULLET tracked the pace along the rail, slipped through inside JUMP STREET to gain the lead on the far turn, then gave way in the drive. SAM'S SONG chased the pace three wide to nearing the stretch, then tired. JUMP STREET set the pace off the rail to past midway of the far turn, then faltered. SECRET BAY prompted the pace to nearing the far turn, then faded and was eased in the final eighth. MY VELVET REVOLVER was done early and eased in the stretch run.
