**Footnotes**

SUBTITLES vied for the lead outside A SHORE THING to deep stretch, then was fully extended to hold off DEVIL IN SPACE. The latter, chased the pace along the inside, angled out for the drive and rallied to just miss. A SHORE THING vied for the lead along the inside into the stretch, his rider lost his whip approaching the eighth pole, continued to contest the pace to deep stretch while being put to pressure by his rider with a pair of goggles, then was outfinished. VOORHEE'S BALLAD bumped with ONEFOR KIERAN at the start, chased the pace into the stretch and closed with a mild response. FORTUNATELY BOLD chased the pace, was steadied in behind rivals on the backstretch and had no late response when asked. SUNSATIONAL failed to menace after breaking slowly. PAYYOURTAX off slowly, tracked the leaders three wide around the turn and tired. BOND CHAMP was not a factor. ONEFOR KIERAN was outrun after being bumped and steadied from between rivals at the start. SALTY'S ACTOR showed little. WHAT A BLAST was done early after bumping with ONEFOR KIERAN at the start and eased in the stretch run.
