LUNA GRANDE outrun early, angled out for the stretch run, rallied to gain command just inside the eighth pole, then drew off. CRISTAL JAK rated off the pace, was caught in tight on the turn, angled four wide and made a run to loom a threat nearing the eighth pole but couldn't match strides with the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. COSMIC SONG stalked the pace along the rail, was checked when unable to get through inside DAISEY LEE nearing the eighth pole and failed to recover. TRUE EXPECTATIONS reserved early, raced five wide around the turn and tired. FASHIONABLE ELSA chased the pace three wide around the turn, then faltered. DAISEY LEE showed speed along the inside to past the eighth pole, then had nothing left. SYLVIA'S TEMPO chased the pace around the turn and faded.
