Footnotes

CARROTS saved ground while stalking the pace, angled outside the leaders at the top of the stretch, rallied to gain the lead nearing the sixteenth pole, then drew clear. ROBYNHOO chased the pace, slipped through along the rail on the backstretch to vie with MACARTHUR CAUSEWAY, contested the pace with that rival to inside the eighth pole but couldn't resist the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. MACARTHUR CAUSEWAY set the early pace, responded when challenged by ROBYNHOO on the backstretch, vied with that rival to inside the eighth pole and weakened. MASON'S MOMENT steadied in the early going, raced three wide and failed to menace. L'S LEGACY reserved in striking position off the pace, lacked a late response. KNOWA tracked the pace into the far turn and tired. MR. IZZY was no factor after breaking slowly. CRISP CAT off slowly, steadied along the inside on the first turn and again nearing the end of the backstretch, then faltered.
