SHARP MIRAGE stalked the pace three wide, made a run to reach MARGIE'S MAGIC leaving the turn, then wore that rival down in a long drive to be just up at the wire. MARGIE'S MAGIC showed speed along the inside, responded when challenged by SHARP MIRAGE racing into the stretch, then just failed to last in a game effort. CARICIA reserved racing off the rail, rallied to be up for the show. GIBSON'S LIL GRACE chased the pace along the inside, angled out for room in the stretch but didn't do enough late. COUNTRY ISLE rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and had no late response. NIKKI'S CHOICE chased the pace off the rail into the stretch and tired. FLYINGWONDER failed to menace. SCARLET BALL allowed to settle, faltered in the drive. JIMMY'S TOO BLUE was not a factor. VIBRANT LIGHT was outrun. OUR SECRET BROAD showed little.
