### Footnotes

FLAMES IN THE SAND, wearing a nasal strip, chased three wide around the turn, rallied to gain command just inside the eighth pole and edged clear under pressure. ANTAGONISER stalked the pace, took over command on the turn but couldn't match strides with the winner in the final eighth. HONEYMOON SWEEP reserved early, improved her position along the inside. BESSIE'S CHIPS, wearing a nasal strip, broke slowly and failed to menace. DON'T DIGRESS chased the leaders four wide around the turn and tired. TIONESTA bumped and checked at the start, was outrun. STYLISH CITY opened a clear lead down the backstretch while angling to the rail, then faded in the drive. KIRI BATI bumped TIONESTA at the start, then stopped leaving the turn when she bled.
