Footnotes

PINK NOTE rated off the pace off the rail, angled in for the stretch run, gained command a sixteenth out and drew off under urging. FOREVER LOVING steadied at the start, rallied four wide from the middle of the pace to just get up for the place. THE DIVAS JUDGE vied for the lead off the rail, edged away in the stretch run, then gave way in deep stretch just missing the place. CHARLESTON CATHY chased the pace three wide and weakened in the drive. TOO MUCH LOVE in good position, saved ground to no avail. TACTFULLY ANN broke in the air, was well placed but lacked a late response. TRAIL OF HONOR reserved off the pace four wide, angled in for the drive and failed to menace. WESTMALAGRA unhurried early, raced five wide around the turn and failed to be a factor. GLORIOUS SANDY ducked in for the start, and saved ground without threatening. VIDS PERFECT TEN vied for the lead along the inside and tired in the drive. FRESQUITA showed brief foot off the rail. FAR AND ABOVE trailed while four wide.
