COUNTESSA tracked the pace along the rail, slipped through inside UNBRIDLED ASHLEY to take over in early stretch, then was fully extended to prevail. MISS DELIA outrun after being steadied in the early going, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to be up for the place while unable to catch the winner. GREY BOUQUET chased the pace three wide into the stretch and weakened. CRAFTY DIVA rated off the pace, made a run four wide on the far turn to reach contention, then gave way in the drive. TUNE UP THE BAND failed to menace. DANCE OF JOY chased the pace, then was checked in behind UNBRIDLED ASHLEY nearing the eighth pole and tired. UNBRIDLED ASHLEY set the pace along the inside, came off the rail for the stretch run and faltered. PROSE was outrun after being steadied along the inside entering the first turn.
