ROYAL PARADE vied for the lead outside BOSCOBELLE to past midway of the turn, then drew away under pressure. WHA'PA tracked the pace, was steadied leaving the backstretch to avoid running up on rivals, angled out three wide and closed to prove second best. BOSCOBELLE vied for the lead along the inside, then gave way in the drive and finished on even terms with SPLICE GIRL. The latter, bobbled soon after the start, tracked the pace four wide into the stretch, tired and dead heated with BOSCOBELLE for the show. CERTITUDE was not a factor. MAZEL DANCER was outrun after being caught in tight at the start. DIAMOND KIND showed little.
