Footnotes

BOOK THE BULLET tracked the pace, eased out and rallied three wide to take over at the quarter pole, then edged away through the stretch while being ridden out. TWIST THE SWORD unhurried early, advanced five wide around the turn to reach near even terms for command entering the stretch but couldn't stay with the winner while clearly second best. PARA VIDINHA off slowly, saved ground around the turn and closed to gain the show while unable to keep pace with the top ones in the drive. LOST VICTORIA allowed to settle, improved her position without threatening. CIMARRONA outrun early, raced five wide on the turn and passed tired rivals. PRINCESS LOLA chased the pace into the stretch and tired. MARTY'S JOIA steadied at the start, moved into contention four wide on the turn, then faltered in the drive. MISS ABERDEEN set the pace, moved to the inside on the turn and faded. BE ON TOP bobbled at the start, showed brief foot, stopped and was eased in the final eighth. IRISH PUNCH was done early and eased in the stretch run.
