Footnotes

LADY SAMURI tracked the pace, rallied to take over in the stretch, then was fully extended to prevail. SING ME A LULLABY bumped with MERCURY MOON at the start, then steadied in behind rivals on the backstretch, eased out to stalk the pace three wide into the stretch but couldn't gain on the winner late while up for the place. PEGASUS SONG allowed to settle, raced three wide around the far turn, then rallied to be up for the show. EMILY'S SPIRIT reserved off the pace after being bumped and steadied at the start, closed with a belated rally to just miss the show. RED LACE chased the pace, moved to take over on the far turn, made the pace into the stretch, then gave way. MERCURY MOON was knocked into EMILY'S SPIRIT at the start and failed to menace. COME SEE COME SA stalked the pace three wide to nearing the stretch, then tired. IT'S A D'WILDCAT set the pace along the rail to the far turn and faded.
